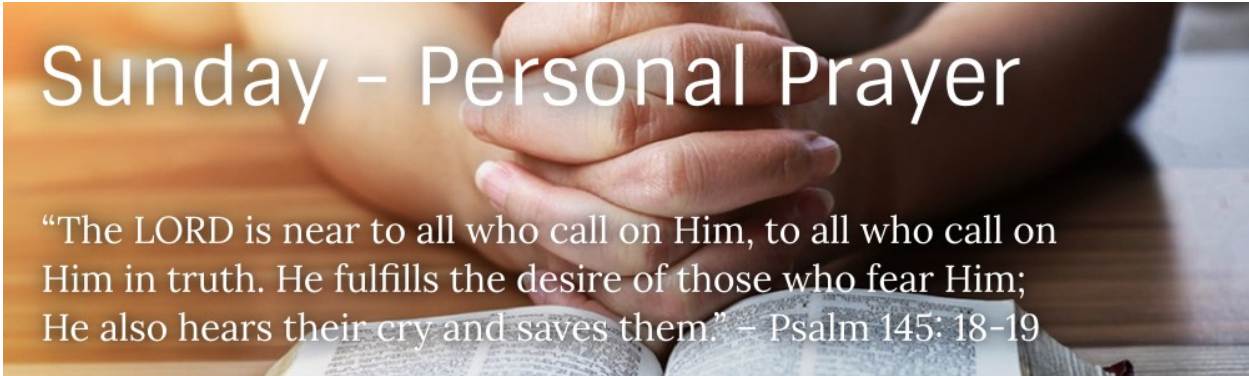
Let's pray boldly, trusting God to work in powerful ways!

Sunday – Personal Prayer

“The LORD is near to all who call on Him, to all who call on Him in truth. He fulfills the desire of those who fear Him; He also hears their cry and saves them.” – Psalm 145: 18-19

Today take some time for focused prayer for the items in your life that bring concern, worry, questions, and take time to intentionally thank our mighty Saviour for the items in your life that are filled with joy, contentment and satisfaction.

The following ideas are six ways in which you can pray for yourself today.

- That God would continually open your eyes to see his worth.

“Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created.” (Revelation 4:11)

- That God would help you live as though he is your treasure in all of life.

“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek and you will find, knock, it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened.” (Matthew 7:7-8)

- That God would help you keep perspective and lean your heart towards him and not toward selfish desires.

“Incline my heart toward you and not toward selfish gain.” (Psalm 119:36)

- That God would lead you to repentance and purify you.

“Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me and lead me in the way everlasting!” (Ps. 139:23-24)

- That God would satisfy your heart.

“Satisfy us in the morning with your steadfast love, that we may rejoice and be glad all the days of our lives.” (Psalm 90:14)



- That God would continually change your heart and make it more like Christ's.

“And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Christ Jesus.” (Philippians 1:6)

As you commit to this week of prayer, ask the Lord to lead you and grow your faith until you pray without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:17) and never lose heart (Luke 18:1). Pray that his kingdom would come in your life and in the lives of your family. Pray the Lord's prayer over you, your family, and friends:

How to to Pray for Missionaries

- Open doors

“Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message. ...” – Colossians 4:2-3a (NIV)

- Boldness

“Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel. ...” – Ephesians 6:19 (NIV)



- Protection

“Pray, too, that we will be rescued from wicked and evil people, for not everyone is a believer.” - 2 Thessalonians 3:2 (NLT)

- Effective ministry

“Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.” - John 15:5 (NLT)

- Refreshment

Then Jesus said, “Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light.” — Matthew 11:28–30 (NLT)

- Witness – that they would walk in a manner Worthy of the Gospel. That they would live lives of integrity (Titus 2:7–8).
- Countries where they serve – for those in authority. For religious freedom and openness to the gospel.

Missionaries Supported by CFBC

- 1) **Mark Naylor** – *Mark continues to work on translation of Hindu Sindhi Scripture passages.*

- Pray for wisdom as Mark mentors 4 men in Pakistan (Papu, Sahib, Timothy and Nathaniel). They are bringing the gospel to their people using the Discovery Bible Study.



- 2) **Mark & Catherine Buhler** – Mark works with refugees and new immigrants in Vancouver. Catherine works with New Hope Community Services Day Care.

- Pray for Mark as he mentors new leaders and that he develops close relations within many ethnic groups in his community.



- 3) **Josh & Jenni Smolder** – The Smolders development of a written language in areas of Ethiopia where there isn't one for Bible translation. They are currently on track with a NT Bible translation for the Opo people.



- Pray for the Opo people. They now have the opportunity to develop their language, but there are temptations along the way.

- 4) **Geordon & Marilyn Rendle** – Geordon continues in his **Global Youth Advocate** role and Marilyn is the **Diaspora Stewardship Director**. Both are working full-time, based in Victoria, interacting both locally and globally, and travelling upon request.



- Pray God would continue to provide the many opportunities for them to speak around the world and the strength to do it.

- 5) **Vancouver Urban Ministries** – This ministry supports vulnerable children in a tutorial program in East Vancouver schools.



- Praise God that they were able to launch a new tutoring hub in Richmond.

- 6) **Niños de la Luz (Children of the Light), located in Dominican Republic, Venezuela, and South Sudan** – NDLL was founded by Jon & Shannon Haslett. This ministry provides stable Christian homes and education on their properties for children who have been abandoned to the streets. Members from CFBC have participated in several short term mission trips.



- Pray for safety during the new construction in South Sudan.

- 7) **Migrant Worker Ministry** – Pastor Carlos Carrion and his wife, Veronica, are a missionary couple who minister to Mexican and Guatemalan migrant workers in the lower mainland. Praise for those being reached by the gospel.



- Pray for these migrant workers who endure the hardship of being away from their families for 2 years to work.

- 8) **Stan and Sandy Anonby, Wycliffe Bible Translators Canada**. Stan and Sandy are involved in language survey to help determine which language groups need Bible translation.



- Pray that God would continue to give them strength for 3 projects in 2026.



- 9) **Rachel Fulmore, Africa Inland Missions.** Rachel is serving in North Africa as a nurse in a Christian hospital. Currently she is teaching nursing classes and going to the villages every week with the diabetes program.

- Please pray for a child at their clinic with a mysterious illness that has stopped her from walking and she doesn't have the right documentation to get further testing.



- 10) **Barry & Sarah Beeler, Overseas Missionary Fellowship,** The Beeler's help people become purposefully involved in what God is doing in the world. Barry is also the coordinator for Serve Asia, OMF's short term mission program.

- January to March is when OMF mobilizers connect with a lot of students across Canada. Pray that God would give each student we meet a personal vision for engaging His Mission.



- 11) **Taeryn Novak – YFC Comox Valley.** Taeryn is serving on staff with YFC Comox Valley as Ministry Communications Administrator and Youth Worker.

- Please pray for wisdom for Taeryn as she works with youth in the Creative Life program. Pray for open hearts.



- 12) **Alberto and Minerva Leiva – YFC Nicaragua** Through this ministry Alberto and his wife, Minerva, have impacted hundreds of lives. Their ministry is thriving in a poverty-stricken environment, through children's ministries, English classes, leadership training, and school ministry.

- Pray for the local church to establish a training collaboration with hundreds of high school students.



- 13) **Pakistan Bible Correspondence School, Sindh** – a national evangelism program providing Bible study courses and discipleship training in Sindh Pakistan.

- Pray that true seekers may read the Bible, find God's Holy Spirit and share the good news to others.

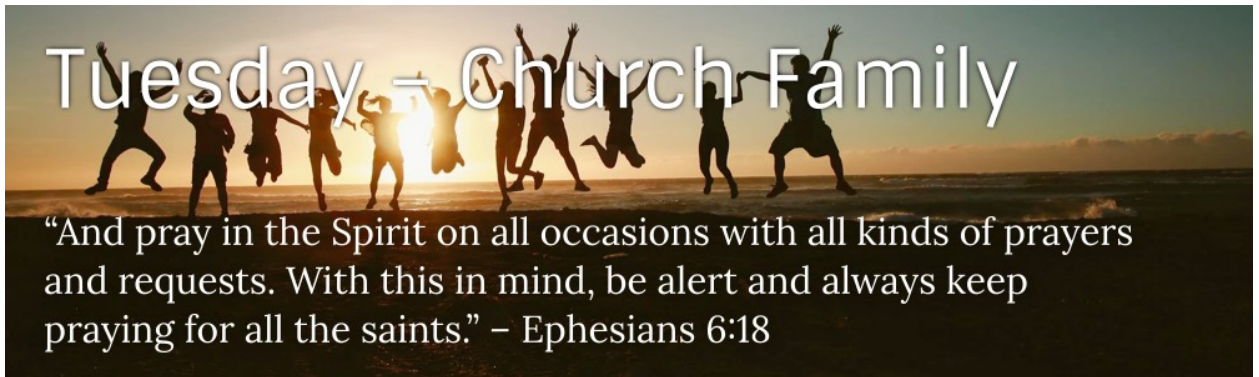


- 14) **Jacob & Rachel Hwang** – Serving Ahousaht and Port Alberni First Nations at Maaqtusiis Community Church.

- Pray for wisdom for parents to raise resilient disciples of Christ in a post-Christian and complex digital age



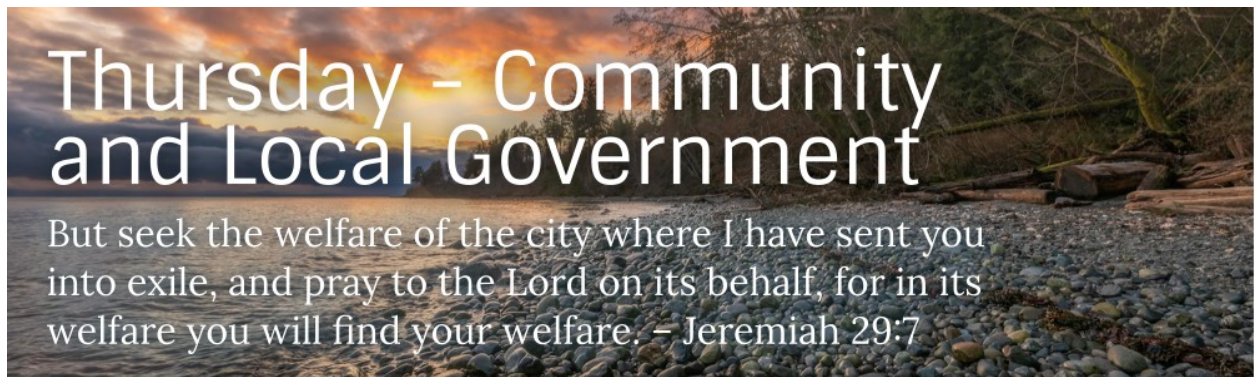
Gospel Communities and Small Groups

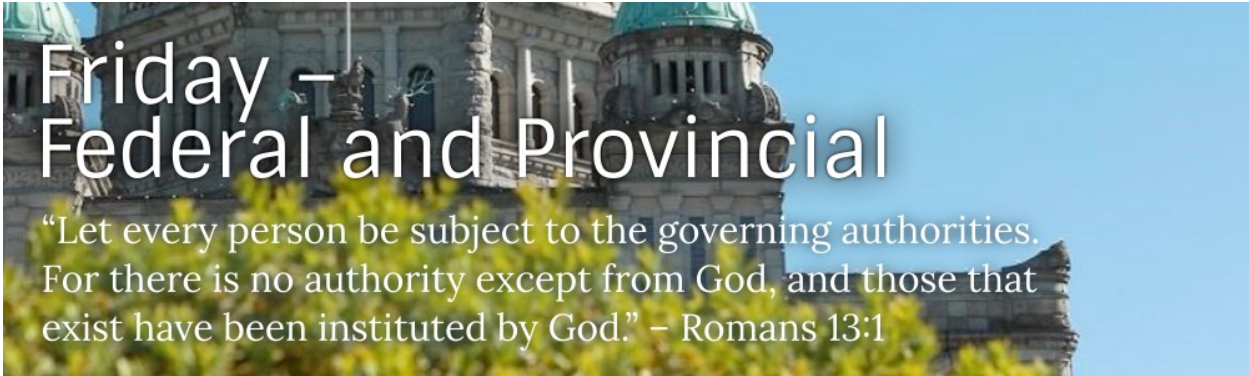

Saturday – The Persecuted Church

“Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body.” – Hebrews 13:3

Canadians experience great freedom of religion compared to so many places in the world. In fact, it is hard for us to think that our brothers and sisters in Christ in other parts of the world are under attack. Churches meet in hiding; believers pray and worship in private; and many live in constant fear of arrest, beatings, or even execution.

We want to offer a prayer today and a few suggestions for how to pray for the persecuted church.

How to Pray for the Persecuted Church.

- **Strength & Perseverance:** Ask God to strengthen believers to endure suffering, find joy in trials, and remain steadfast in their faith (Ephesians 3:16-19, 2 Corinthians 12:9).
- **Protection & Deliverance:** Pray for physical safety from harm, rescue from dangerous situations, and protection from evil (Psalm 91, 2 Thessalonians 3:2-3, Matthew 26:39).
- **Boldness & Wisdom:** Pray for courage to share the Gospel fearlessly and wisdom in conversations and decisions (Ephesians 6:20, Colossians 4:5-6).
- **Provision:** Ask God to meet practical needs like food, shelter, medical care, jobs, and spiritual resources like Bibles (3 John 2, Philippians 4:19, James 1:5).
- **Community & Family:** Pray for strong Christian fellowships, comfort when families are broken by persecution, and for the reunification of separated loved ones (Galatians 6:2, 1 Corinthians 12).
- **For Persecutors:** Pray for their hearts to be softened, that they might come to know Jesus (Matthew 5:44, Acts 16).



- **For the Church Body:** Pray that the global church would feel connected to the suffering body of Christ and be motivated to pray (1 Corinthians 12:20, 26).

Whether it's enduring physical torture or simply being able to provide enough food for their families, persecuted believers often face many hardships. May we all remember that our hope lies in the world to come and not in this world.
